Clement-Moore, Rosemary. *Highway to Hell.*

On their way to spend spring break on a Texas beach, college freshmen Maggie Quinn and D&D Lisa are stranded in a town where some believe a chupacabra is killing animals, and as the girls investigate they get help from diverse and unexpected sources. [Third book in the *Maggie Quinn: Girl vs Evil* series]

Dowd, Siobhan. *The London Eye Mystery.*

When Ted and Kat's cousin Salim disappears from the London Eye ferris wheel, the two siblings must work together--Ted with his brain that is "wired differently" and impatient Kat--to try to solve the mystery of what happened to Salim.

Feinstein, John. *Change-up : Mystery at the World Series.*

While covering baseball's World Series between the Washington Nationals and the Boston Red Sox, teenage sports reporters Stevie and Susan Carol investigate a rookie pitcher whose evasive answers during an interview reveal more than a few contradictions in his life story. [Fourth book in a series]

Ferguson, Alane. *The Dying Breath : A Forensic Mystery.*

When her ex-boyfriend starts stalking her, seventeen-year-old Cameryn must use her knowledge of forensic sciences to protect herself. [Fourth book in the *Forensic Mystery* series]

Grisham, John. *Theodore Boone : Kid Lawyer.*

With two attorneys for parents, thirteen-year-old Theodore Boone knows more about the law than most lawyers do. But when a high profile murder trial comes to his small town and Theo gets pulled into it, it's up to this amateur attorney to save the day.

Henderson, Lauren. *Kiss Me Kill Me.*

Longing to be part of the in-crowd at her exclusive London school, orphaned, sixteen-year-old Scarlett, a trained gymnast, eagerly accepts an invitation to a party whose disastrous outcome changes her life forever.

Jinks, Catherine. *The Reformed Vampire Support Group.*

Fifteen-year-old vampire Nina has been stuck for fifty-one years in a boring support group for vampires, and nothing exciting has ever happened to them--until one of them is murdered and the others must try to solve the crime.

Staub, Wendy Corsi. *Lily Dale : Discovering.*

After almost being killed while trying to discover how her mother died, Calla tries desperately to use both her psychic powers and investigative skills to learn the truth about

her mother's life, and to find out what these secrets may mean for her. [Fourth book in the *Lily Dale* series]

Taylor, G. P. *The Secret of Indigo Moon.*

Erik Morrissey Ganger and his friend, fourteen-year-old Sadie Dopple, meet a wealthy recluse while trying to escape tunnels under Isambard Dunstan's School for Wayward children in order to pursue a former foe who has inadvertently kidnapped Sadie's twin sister, Saskia. [Second book in the *Doppelganger Chronicles* series]

Wynne-Jones, Tim. *The Uninvited*

After a disturbing freshman year at New York University, Mimi is happy to get away to her father's remote Canadian cottage only to discover a stranger living there who has never heard of her or her father and who is convinced that Mimi is responsible for leaving sinister tokens around the property.
