

# New Science Fiction For Teens

**Dashner, James. *The Maze Runner*.**

Sixteen-year-old Thomas wakes up with no memory in the middle of a maze and realizes he must work with the community in which he finds himself if he is to escape. [First book in the *Maze Runner Trilogy*]

**Fisher, Catherine. *Incarceron*.**

To free herself from an upcoming arranged marriage, Claudia, the daughter of the Warden of Incarceron, a futuristic prison with a mind of its own, decides to help a young prisoner escape. [First book in the *Incarceron* series]

**Klass, David. *Timelock*.**

Jack discovers that the only way to protect the Earth from ecological disaster at the hands of the Dark Army is to lock time, and he must choose between staying in the present or returning to the future world from which he came. [Third book in the *Caretaker Trilogy*]

**Pfeffer, Susan Beth. *This World We Live In*.**

When the moon's gravitational pull increases, causing massive natural disasters on earth, Miranda and her family struggle to survive in a world without cities or sunlight, and wonder if anyone else is still alive. [Third book in the *Last Survivors* series]

**Reeve, Philip. *Fever Crumb*.**

Foundling Fever Crumb has been raised as an engineer although females in the future London, England, are not believed capable of rational thought, but at age fourteen she leaves her sheltered world and begins to learn startling truths about her past while facing danger in the present.

**Ryan, Carrie. *The Forest of Hands and Teeth*.**

Through twists and turns of fate, orphaned Mary seeks knowledge of life, love, and especially what lies beyond her walled village and the surrounding forest, where dwell the unconsecrated, aggressive flesh-eating people who were once dead. [First book in the *Forest of Hands and Teeth* series]

**Slade, Arthur G. *The Hunchback Assignments*.**

In Victorian London, fourteen-year-old Modo, a shape-changing hunchback, becomes a secret agent for the Permanent Association, which strives to protect the world from the evil machinations of the Clockwork Guild. [First book in the *Hunchback Assignments* series]

**Snyder, Maria V. *Inside Out*.**

"...I'm Trella. I'm a scrub. A nobody. One of thousands who work the lower levels, keeping inside clean for the Uppers. I've got one friend, do my job, and try to avoid the Pop Cops. So what if I occasionally use the pipes to sneak around the Upper levels. The only neck at risk is my own...until I accidentally start a rebellion and become the go-to-girl to lead a revolution"--Cover, P.[4].

**Wasserman, Robin. *Crashed*.**

Living with other "mechs" since her wealthy parents transplanted her brain into a mechanical body to prevent her from dying in a horrible accident, Lia becomes a pawn in a religious leader's movement to outlaw "mech" technology and eradicate machines such as Lia. [Second book in the *Skinned* series]

**Westerfeld, Scott. *Leviathan*.**

In an alternate 1914 Europe, fifteen-year-old Austrian Prince Alek, on the run from the Clanker Powers who are attempting to take over the globe using mechanical machinery, forms an uneasy alliance with Deryn who, disguised as a boy to join the British Air Service, is learning to fly genetically-engineered beasts. [First book in the *Leviathan* series]
